Hi Bob,

Sorry to miss a meeting with the gang. In answer to your question, I'm "hanging out" at my home in Cape Vincent, NY. The weather has been on my side. Didn't have to put the boat up until early December.

The tail is wagging the dog—I'm printing note cards and Xmas cards for eight other artists as well as my own stuff. (Printed better than 5000 so

far this year). Scan the originals with an HP — if larger use either the digital camera or a 4x5 Linhof (Polaroid sheet film). Still printing on HP printers. Currently my workhorse is a HP1100. Use the HP850 for Postcard books, bus.card size magnets and less critical stuff. Am thinking about getting an HP 2000 to see if the separate ink cartridges will save any money. Presently the yellow ink cartridge runs out — usually in the middle of a run resulting in high spoilage and necessitating replacing the cartridge with still unusable red and blue ink in them. As the ink is about 50% of the cost, I'm

TEACHER: Now I see where this is going. Alice, what is this color?

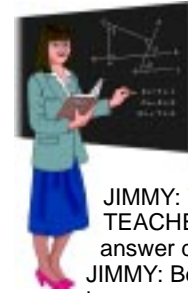
ALICE: **Grape.**

looking for all ways to cut corners. Tried refills but the nuisance, lack of faithful color reproduction, and a very little, if any cost savings ended that approach.

I have the artists furnish color swatches of their basic colors and find I can get good duplication. Use Coral Photoprint for tweaking and cropping. Then format in MS Publisher. Print 2 up on std. sheet. Note cards in single pass. Cards with verses — 2 up and two passes.

Still dabbling in gemstones, using Gemcad to precut before the actual faceting. Making gemstone appraisals (on computer of course). Just got a CD burner and find I can turn out good copies of musical CDs. The artists want to turn out CDs of their work so I guess I'll get mixed up in that. Still using PCs up North but keep my Mac SE going down here. Using a EK DC120 for digital picts.
